Pursuant to Sec. 551.087, deliberation regarding Economic Development Negotiations including (I) discussion or deliberation regarding commercial or financial information that the governmental body has received from a business prospect that

the governmental body seeks to have locate, stay, or expand in or near the territory of the governmental body and with which the governmental body is conducting economic negotiations; QR(2) deliberation of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect described in (1) above.
