The Roll Call was taken, showing Alderman Jeff Neu and Robert Sharp absent. Establishing a quorum, Mayor Scott Neu called the meeting to order at 7PM.

The first item on the agenda, Preliminary Plat of the Hess Grocery Property was tabled until a future Council Meeting; the building has to be redesigned due to an existing easement.

Mayor Scott Neu informed the council that per the City Attorney, he will excuse himself due to conflict of interest for the voting on the Final Plat of Nortman Estates, Section 7 owned by Michael Hermes, due to a conflict of interest. Klay Gilbert inquired about the ten feet easement on the east and the fifteen feet easement on the west. Chris Frerich explained the fifteen feet easement reduces the extra manhole required. At 7:02 Mayor Neu excused himself from the Council Meeting for the voting of the final plat. The vote carried 3-0. Mayor Neu returned to the meeting at 7:03PM.

Klay Gilbert spoke to the Council under Alderman's reports stating a number of potholes are filled and no longer are problems. Sam Sparkman reported the drain on Pecan and Bezner has been cleaned out and is functioning properly.

Mayor Scott Neu spoke to the Council regarding the Bezner/Block private sewer line. He stated he is awaiting a quote from Patterson Professional Services.
