Invocation and Pledge of Allegiances were led by Scott Neu. The Roll Call was then taken showing Klay Gilbert absent. Establishing a quorum, Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:01PM.

No one signed to speak under Citizen's Comments.

The Consent Agenda was approved as presented on a motion by Jeff Neu and a second by Glenn Block. Motion carried 4-0.

A brief discussion took place on a proposed stop sign at the intersection of Fourth Street and North Maple Street. The Council decided to place a four-way stop sign at the intersection of Fourth and North Maple and replace the four way stop sign at the intersection of Fourth and Pecan with yield signs. The motion to accept the street sign changes were made by Glenn Block, seconded by Sam Sparkman. Motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Neu stated that the City has a leash law ordinance for dogs but feels that the City also needs an ordinance for vicious dogs. Any citizen could file a complaint of a vicious dog. The county has a contract with Refinery Road Veterinary to impound the dog at the owner's expense. Jeff Neu made a motion to accept Ordinance 0620-1, regarding vicious dogs, Robert Sharp seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

A motion made by Jeff Neu, seconded by Robert Sharp to renew the agreement for Fire Protection Services with the Lindsay Volunteer Fire Department. The noted change replaced the reimbursed phone expenses with reimbursement of internet expense not to exceed \$1000.00 yearly. The motion carried 4-0.

The Council voted to change the Council regular meeting date from the second Monday of each month to the first Tuesday of each month, since the City Attorney has recently been reassigned on the second Mondays. The motion to change the date was made by Robert Sharp, seconded by Sam Sparkman. Motion carried

4-0.

The last thing on the agenda was an emergency item to discuss the repair or replacement of the City Hall's failed air conditioner unit. A motion made by Sam Sparkman, seconded by Jeff Neu to allow Mayor Neu to approve the repair or replacement of the unit with the amount not to exceed \$10,000.00. Motion carried 4-0.

There were no reports under Information Reports.
