The mayor opened the meeting at 6:39 PM. The Mayor reviewed and explained the franchise fees collected, the 2020 certified property tax totals and schedule of debt payments for 2020-2021.

Next Mayor Neu explained the list of proposed projects, mainly consisting of waterline extension and sewer line extension near Highway 82. The Mayor provided information about the funding opportunities for proposed projects listed in the proposed budget.

There was a lengthy discussion on the proposed tax rates. The consensus was to keep the tax rate of .4862, the same as last year, with the I&S being set at the rate to pay the debt payments.

Discussion took place regarding commercial water rates and various recycle option. Both will be revisited at a future meeting.

The Council stated they are interested in budgeting money for street repairs. Several streets need repair, but no consensus was made on which location should be repaired.
