Citizen Comments: None


Mayor Neu reviewed and explained the franchise fees collected as well as the mixed beverage and hotel/motel tax comparisons. He addressed the council explaining 'the 2021 certified property tax totals and the debt payments for 2021-20224 He suggested keeping the current tax rate of .048620, stating this is will be a much tighter budget than in the past. The 2021-2022 has made allotments for the cost of living and inflation, with utilities seeing a large increase. The sewer has also seen a large increase in expenditures during the 2020-2021 budget year.
