

RESOLUTION NO. 091421-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LINDSAY, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE PROPERTY TAX REVENUE INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE BUDGET OF THE CITY OF LINDSAY FOR THE TAX YEAR 2021-2022

WHEREAS, a tax rate of \$.021371 of Maintenance and Operation and a tax rate of \$.027249 for Interest and Sinking for a Total Tax Rate of \$.0486200 per \$100.00 valuation is necessary, appropriate, and required for the funding of the approved budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 for the City of Lindsay; and

WHEREAS, THE APPROVED BUDGET WILL RAISE MORE TOTAL PROPERTY TAX REVENUE THAN WAS GENERATED IN THE PREVIOUS BUDGET YEAR OF 2020-2021 BY \$40,327.30 and

WHEREAS, the approved budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 for the City of Lindsay has been adopted by the governing body of the City of Lindsay; and

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code (LGC), Section 102.007 (c) requires a separate vote to "ratify" the property tax revenue reflected in the budget.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINDSAY, TEXAS:

In compliance with the requirements of Section 102.007 (c), Texas Local Government Code, the City Council of the City of Lindsay does hereby in all things ratify the property tax increase reflected in the approved budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022, which will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year.
