**Consider/take action on contract with Atlas Municipal Services to provide the inspection service for the city.** Mr. Swain spoke to the council regarding Atlas Municipal Services. He stated his company will provide a quick turnaround on the plan review approval process. The company's goal is customer service and to look at each permit and review with the City of Lindsay's requests and make both the city satisfied as well as the residence. **Consider/take action on the \$7250.00 grant money for bullet shield for the Police Department.** Major Neu addressed the council stating this is a reimbursement grant for 1 full length and ½ length shield. The grant was established due to the Uvalde school shootings and it was applied for at the end of 2022.
