Consent Agenda for 5 – The minutes from March was not presented. A motion was made to accept the consent agenda excluding the March minutes. Accept Motion- Klay Gilbert

Consider/take action the Careflite for the City Council. The cost of \$1.00 per month per member was discussed. Accept Motion- Klay Gilbert Second- Jeff Neu Vote- 5-0

Consider/take action on the water drainage on Willow Street. David Arendt spoke to the council and discussed the pictures that Jeff Neu presented to the council. Mr. Arendt stated concerns about the water that flows around his property from the Fourth Street and Willow Street drainage, saying he feels the water comes from the church and school. He stated concerns on the main entrance to his house and the washing of soil around the culvert in his driveway. Mayor Neu informed Mr. Arendt that the city will contact the engineer for advice on how to reroute the excess flow and there will be a need for drainage easements. Mr. Arendt stated that the west side of his property can be used for drainage to aid in correcting the water.

Consider/take action on obligating COVID funds. Mayor Neu stated the funds are required to be obligated for spending by December 2024. Mayor Neu suggested using the funds to start the upgrade process for the wastewater treatment plant. Accept Motion-Klay Gilbert
